# kalanchoe plant



---

difficulty level: *easy*

scientific name: *Kalanchoe*

type of plant: *flowering evergreen,  
succulent, common*

---



*Toxic to pets and humans when ingested.*

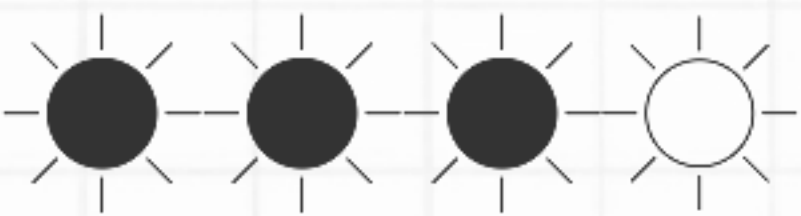


*Between 65 and 85 degrees Fahrenheit. Sensitive to drafts.*



*Plant in potting mix of 50% potting soil and 50% cactus mix.  
Plant in container with good drainage.*

### light level



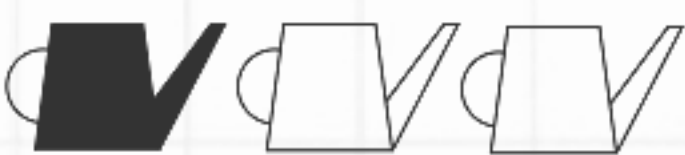
*Place in bright, indirect light. Prolonged  
direct sunlight will burn the leaves.*

### watering needs



*As a succulent, this plant will store water in  
it's leaves. Let it dry out between good  
waterings. No misting required.*

### fertilizer needs



*Low. During the warmer months, feed  
monthly with succulent fertilizer at half  
strength. Do not fertilize in the winter or  
when the plant is in bloom.*

---

*notes/tips:* *If it begins to grow leggy, allow the plant more sunlight.  
When the leaves become dusty, wipe them gently with a  
wet cloth. Blooms will return again with average care--and last a long time!*
